PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Players and families;

Welcome to the 2007/2008 Hillview After School Basketball Tournament Team Program. We are excited to have your child/children participate in this healthy, fun activity. To insure an understanding among all parties we'd like to cover player, coach, and family responsibilities and expectations.

- 1) Players/coaches show up and are on time to games/practices.
- 2) Attendance to games & practices are vital to the success of each team. Coaches and team mates are counting on each other to make the team a cohesive unit.
- 3) We understand that there are other commitments, but players should make every effort to attend. If missing a practice or game can't be avoided we insist coaches be notified as soon as possible. These should be very minimum.
- 4) Players are not only responsible to their teams, but are expected to be responsible as Hillview Students. Any student suspended from school will sit out their next team's game. Additional consequences may be forthcoming. Students not keeping up with their school work or having disciplinary concerns may have consequences. In this case parents will be notified before a decision is made. Students home ill are not allowed to participate that day.
- 5) Sportsmanship is always a major concern. Players are expected to be supportive & respectful of teammates, opponents, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- 6) Disruptive behavior at practice or games will not be tolerated.
- 7) Players will NOT be issued uniforms or be able to play in games until this form is signed and returned to either Mr. Bell, Coach Plummer, or Coach Weil.
- 8) Families will be responsible to pay for uniforms not returned at the end of season. The cost is up to \$40 per uniform.
- 9) It is mandated all tournament team players participate in the MPMSL league (balanced Monday League). Players/families are expected to devote the same commitment/enthusiasm to balanced team league as they are the tournament team.
- 10) Parents are welcome to discuss concerns/complaints with coaches/coordinator, but please not in front of players or at games. Phone calls/emails are appropriate.
